This includes: entry fee (cash, money order, or check), signed contestant rules and regulations, completed applications, and 1 5x7 headshot on photograph paper. B. Contestants are required to attend the Contestant meeting and pageant practice on **April 7th**, **2025 at 6:00 PM**.
